Certainly, a traumatic injury to the neck or back can cause acute spine pain (and often chronic pain as well). But most neck and back pain is due to age-related changes in the spinal anatomy or indirect forces on the vertebrae that cause them to slip out of alignment.

After a head, neck, or back injury, do any of these problems occur? • Pain from a head, neck, or back injury lasts longer than 1 week or goes away and returns. • Signs of infection (e.g., redness, fever, pus, drainage, etc.) occur at the site of the wound. • A whiplash injury is suspected.

Could That Pain In Your Neck Be Causing Headaches?

Cervicogenic headaches are sometimes misdiagnosed as either migraine or cluster headaches (headaches that originate in the head). HOW DOES NECK PAIN CAUSE HEADACHES? The roots of the upper 3 cervical spinal nerves (located at C1, C2, and C3) share a pain nucleus (which routes pain signals to the brain) with the trigeminal nerve.

Any blow to the head can result in a head injury. Head injuries can cause damage to the scalp - such as a minor bump on the head or scalp wound that bleeds. Symptoms include pain felt in the back, neck, and/or head. The pain can be severe.
